4. At the beginning of his defense, what did Paul point out that King Agrippa was familiar with? (26:1-3) What did he point out that the Jews were familiar with? (26:4-12) Why did he do this?
5. What did Paul first say was the reason why he was on trial? (26:6-8) Why did he make such a point of this? What did he later say was another reason? (26:20-21) If you were put on trial for being a Christian, what would you say?
