This chapter reads like an adventure story with Paul lost at sea for two weeks in a violent storm, and finally being shipwrecked on a strange island.

1. Who accompanied Paul to Rome? (27:1-2) How did this honor God's word and will? How do you think Paul felt about this? How would you have?
2. Did the voyage to Rome start out well or with difficulty? (27:3-9) What did Paul prophesy to the ship's crew and Roman guard concerning it? (27:10) Did they listen to Paul? How did they decide what to do? (27:11-12) What does this teach us for our own life? What was the consequence of the centurion not taking Paul's advice? (27:13-41) What can we learn from this for our own life?
3. How did Paul encourage the passengers on the ship in the midst of their trouble? (27:21-26, & 33-36) How was he able to do this? (27:23-25) What effect did it have on them? (27:36)
