1. After Paul and all of the other passengers shipwrecked on the island of Malta, how did the people there treat them? (28:2, 7, 10) Why? (28:2-6, 8-9) If a group of people unknown to you showed up at your home, how would you treat them? Why?
2. How were Paul and the others able to leave the island and get to Rome? (28:11-16) What happened on the way to Rome? (28:13-15) How did this effect Paul? (28:15) How can you do this for someone?
3. How did the Romans treat Paul in Rome? (28:16, 30-31)
4. What did Paul do shortly after arriving in Rome? (28:17-20, 23, 25-28) What was the response to this? (28:21-22, 24-25) What was Paul's response to that? (28:28) What can we learn from this for our own life?

5. What did Paul do the rest of his time in Rome? (28:30-31) How are you spending your life?

6. Through the book of Acts we have seen God deliver Paul through many difficulties, but not deliver him from having them. Why do you think God did it this way? What does this tell us for our own life?

7. Now that we have finished studying Acts, what is the most important thing that you have learned from it for your life?
