1. What were Peter and John doing at the beginning of this chapter? (3:1) What does this tell us we should be doing?
2. Why did Peter and John look straight at the crippled man, and tell him to look at them? (3:4-5)
3. Peter did not have money to give to the crippled man, but what did he give him instead? (3:6-7)
4. When did the crippled man's feet and ankles become strong? (3:7) What does this tell us concerning our ministry to others?
5. How did the man respond to the healing? (3:8) Have you been healed by Jesus? If you have, how have you responded?
6. How did the people in the temple respond to his healing? (3:9-11)

7. How did Peter respond to his healing (3:12-26)

8. What are the different ways Peter describes Jesus in his talk to the people at the temple? (3:13-14,18, 22,26)

9. How does Peter describe himself and John? (3:15) Do you describe yourself this way?

10. How does Peter say that the crippled man became healed? (3:16) Does this still apply today? If it does, are you using it?

11. How did Peter back up his statements about Jesus? (3:18-24) How do you back up your statements about Jesus?

12. What did Peter tell the people to do so that their sins would be wiped out? (3:19) Have you done this? If they did this, what else did he say would happen? (3:19-20, 26) Have you experienced this?

13. Why did Peter say Jesus must remain in heaven, and when did he say Jesus will return? (3:21)
