1. What was the complaint, and who made it among the early Christians in chapter 6? (6:1) Where did this problem come from? Are there similar situations of sin in God's church today?
2. What was the solution reached, and by whom? (6:2-3)
3. This is considered to be the start of the Deacons. What qualifications are mentioned for them? (6:3) Are they still true for today's Deacons?
4. What did the apostles say they were going to give their attention to doing? (6:4) Should we be doing these same things?

5. What do we notice about the believers who were chosen? (6:5)
  
6. What did the apostles do for them? (6:6)
  
7. What was the result of the church's successfully taking care of its first internal problem? (6:7)
  
8. What kind of Christian was Stephen? (6:5, 8) What kind of Christian are you?
  
9. What kind of things did he do? (6:8) What kind of things are you doing for the Lord?
  
10. Stephen received opposition, though, for carrying out his faith. Who was responsible for this? (6:9) How did he handle it? (6:10) What enabled him to do this so well? (6:3, 5, 10) Have you received opposition for carrying out your faith? How did you handle it? What can we learn from Stephen's example for our own life?

11. Since his opponents could not stand up to what Stephen said, what did they do? (6:11-14) What was Stephen's reaction to this? (6:15) If this happened to you, how do you think you would have reacted?
