Note: to fully understand Saul's/Paul's conversion and call to discipleship by Jesus in verses 1-30 of this chapter, Acts 22:3-21 and Acts 26:12-20 should also be read.

1. What happened to Saul while he was traveling to Damascus? (9:1-9) What do we learn for today and our own life from what happened to Saul?
2. What can we learn for our life from the example of Saul and Ananias in Damascus? (9:10-19)
3. What did Saul do as he stayed in Damascus? (9:19-22) What was the response of the people there? (9:23-25) What does this tell us for our life?
4. What happened when Saul went to Jerusalem? (9:26-30)

5. What good things from God did the church receive at this time? (9:31) Can we pray for these things for our church?

6. Why did many people become Christians in Lydda, Sharon, and Joppa? What can we learn from what Peter did for our own life? (9:32-43)
