1. What was the king's dream that terrified him? (4:5-17) What do you do with your dreams; do you try to interpret them? Why could Daniel interpret the dream, yet none of the wise men of Babylon could? (4:8, 18) Why did Daniel hesitate to tell the king the meaning of the dream, and what did it mean? (4:19-26) How do you handle it when a person should be told something negative about themselves?
2. What advice did Daniel give the king so that he possibly would not have to experience the meaning of the dream? (4:27) How does this show Daniel's courage? What do we learn for our own life from Daniel's advice? Did the king take Daniel's advice? (4:28-30) What happened to him? (4:33-36)
3. What lessons did King Nebuchadnezzar learn from his experience? (4: 17, 32, 34-35, 37) What can we learn? What actions did he take in response to what he learned? (4:1-3, 34-35, 37) What actions can we take?
