3. After Daniel was thrown into the lion's den, why did the lions not kill him? (6:21-23) What does this tell us for our own life? Why hasn't God rescued believers at other times, but allowed them to be killed?
4. As a result of God's miraculous protection of Daniel, what did King Darius do? (6:24-28)
