

## Ephesians 3:14-21

These verses in Ephesians could be called “The Power Prayer of Paul”. Here he asks for God’s power to be at work in Christians, while also acknowledging that it is at work in them.

1. What does verse 16 say that Christians need to be strengthened with? How? Where? When this happens, what will be the result according to verse 17?
2. What does verse 17 say our life should be rooted and established in? Is yours? In what ways and to what extent?
3. When this is true and we have the power of God in our life, what 3 things does Paul pray in verses 17-19 that we would experience as a Christian?
4. What does verse 19 say that is greater than knowledge? Do you have it in your life?
5. What does verse 20 say that God’s power in us can do? What does this say about how we can live our life? Have you experienced this? How?
6. What does verse 21 say that the Church is to do for God? Do you think it is? Do you think our church is?
