

Ephesians 4:17-32

1. Besides living as God wants us to in our actions, how else does verse 17 say God wants us to live?
2. What does verse 18 say causes a person to be separated from God and futile in their thinking? What else does this cause according to verse 19? And what does this result in? What does this tell us about our life?
3. Verses 22-24 say to put off our old self and to put on our new self. How does it say to specifically do this? Have you done this? Are you continuing to do this?
4. Verses 25-32 point out other ways for us to put on our new self. What are they? Are you doing this?

5. Anger can be a problem for anyone. What does verse 26 say we need to do to keep our anger from becoming sinful? Are you able to do this? If we do not do this, what does verse 27 say will happen between us and the devil? Also, if we do not do this, what does verse 30 say will happen between us and the Holy Spirit? Knowing this, what do you plan to do when you become angry? Because of verses 27 and 30, what are we told to do in verses 31-32? Are you able to? What does verse 32 say can be a motive to help us forgive others?

6. What does verse 28 say is one reason for us to work? Are you doing this?

7. What does verse 29 say should be the guidelines for what we say? Are you doing this?
