6. What two things does verse 4 say that God's great and precious promises can do for us? Has this been your experience?

7. A) What do verses 5-7 say we should have in our life besides faith? B) Do you have these things in your life? To what degree? C) The more we have them in our life, the more they will keep us from having what bad thing happen to our knowledge of Jesus according to verse 8? D) Do you feel your knowledge of Jesus is productive? How? E) If we do not have these things in our life, what consequence will take place in it according to verse 9? F) If we have these things in our life, what three wonderful things will be true for us according to verses 10-11?

8. A) What event in Jesus' life is Peter referring to in verses 16-18? B) What does this tell us about Jesus? C) What else testifies to who Jesus is according to verse 19? D) How do these things affect your life?
